Translation

Doctor: Hello! Kidney Transplant Inpatient Service Section.

Investigator: Hi, how are you? Is this the Second Affiliated Hospital of Hainan Medical University?

Doctor: Yeah.

Investigator: Yeah, Yeah, I would like to know if you still do kidney transplants at this hospital now?

Doctor: Ah?

Investigator: Kidney transplants...do you do kidney transplants?

Doctor: Yeah, right, at this hospital.

Investigator: At your hospital, do you do that now?

Doctor: We do!

Investigator: If we come, about how long do we have to wait before it can be done?

Doctor: For that, you have to wait for a kidney source! There must be a kidney source first!

Investigator: Oh, are there plenty of kidney sources in your hospital? Are there?

Doctor: Regarding a kidney source, a patient needs to get the tissue typing done! If the patient is suitable, and moves up to the top spot in the queue, then he gets his turn!

Investigator: Are there many patients waiting in your queue now?

Doctor: A lot!

Investigator: Oh, you've got a long waiting list...

Doctor: Basically we don't have enough kidney sources to go around, basically, yeah! It's all about the kidney sources, which definitely fall short! The whole country is like that.

Investigator: Then how do you acquire your kidney sources? Through what channel do you find the kidney sources? Why do they fall short so much?

Doctor: I...about that, how would I know!

Investigator: Oh.

Doctor: Oh. If you want to come for that, just come! Okay?

Investigator: Do you...do you do a lot of cases at this hospital? Do you do a lot a year?

Doctor: Ah? In a year, we do a lot! Anything wrong?

Investigator: No, I mean if you do a lot, then I feel my wait will be hopeful! I'd like to know how many cases you do per year, such as kidney transplants?

Doctor: Fifty, 60 cases a year! In the range between 60 and 70 cases.

Investigator: Oh yeah, below 100 cases?

Doctor: Ah?

Investigator: Not, not as many as 100 cases, right? You can't do that many?

Doctor: Yes, yes, yes, yes.

Investigator: You can, uh, you can do up to 100 cases, can you?

Doctor: Yes, yes.

Investigator: Yes! Oh, well, regarding the kidney sources, we don't know where they come from, like that in the past...

Doctor: I don't know much details about those sources. They could be donated from patients or family members. How would I know!

Investigator: Well, my question is...

Doctor: Oh, I have to go now, oh, if you want to come, then you just come over! Okay?

Investigator: How much does it cost to have a kidney transplant now? How much?

Doctor: For such a single surgery, you need to prepare 400,000 to 500,000 yuan!

Investigator: Oh, it starts from 400,000 to... yeah, uh, which director does that at your hospital? Can I contact that director?

Doctor: Come over first before you contact him! Come over to the inpatients service first, oh.

Investigator: Which director should I contact?

Doctor: You come to the hospital first, then, there is a designated person to help check you in. The director doesn't deal with these things.

Investigator: Well, I'd like to know if Director Zhang Guoqing is still with your hospital?

Doctor: Zhang Guoqing is no longer doing that now.

Investigator: Oh, he stopped doing kidney transplants?

Doctor: Yeah, yeah, he's retired.

Investigator: Oh, already retired...

Doctor: And he is not doing that...

Investigator: Oh, he's retired. Oh, is he still in your hospital?

Doctor: Hum, okay, okay, I got to go.
