Summary

1. “The shortest (organ) wait time is 2 or 3 days, the longest is more than 10 days.”
2. “We have plenty of donors.”
3. (The investigator asked about the type of donors.) “No comment, no comment. Please do not ask about this.”
4. (The investigator asked about the number of operations they had done in 2015.) “Don’t ask about these things!”

Investigation Recording

Investigator: I have a patient, who needs a liver transplant. I heard from my friends that you can do it at your hospital, right?

Doctor: We can do it. Where are you from?

Investigator: My relative is in Zhengzhou. I am in Guangzhou. I want to know how much it costs to do a liver transplant.

Doctor: Does he have Hepatitis B?

Investigator: No.

Doctor: What serious illness does he have to make him in need of liver transplantation?

Investigator: He has hepatitis B. The doctors diagnosed him. He needs liver transplantation. Blood type B.

Doctor: Oh. He has hepatitis B. About 500,000 yuan.

Investigator: Let me ask, how long does he need to wait?

Doctor: The shortest wait time is 2 or 3 days, the longest is more than 10 days.

Investigator: Oh. I asked a few hospitals. Your place is quite fast, faster than the big hospitals in Shanghai. Your donors are healthy, right?

Doctor: Yes, they are.

Investigator: How come your donors arrive faster than the big hospitals in Beijing? You

have plenty of donors!

Doctor: Yes, we have plenty of donors.

Investigator: What kind of donors are yours?

Doctor: No comment, no comment. Please do not ask about this.

Investigator: Oh. Do not ask about this?

Doctor: Right. Do not ask about it.

Investigator: How do I find you then?

Doctor: 16th Floor, Liver Transplantation Department.

Investigator: What is your surname? How should I address you?

Doctor: Just look for Liver Transplantation (Department, okay? (He didn't reveal his name, as he seemed very cautious.)

Investigator: Just need to wait for 2 or 3 days after we come?

Doctor: Yes. In the fast cases, there are 3 or 2 days. It depends on each patient's condition.

Investigator: How many operations have you done this year?

Doctor: Don't ask about these things!
