Investigator: Ah. Well, it is your hospital that does the best job in Wuhan, right?

Nurse: Right, right, right.

Investigator: So how many cases can you do in a year? Some people suggested that I skip all hospitals that perform 100+ or 200+ cases but only talk to those that perform 500 or 600 cases. They told me to only look for those large ones.

Nurse: Well, since I don't have the data at hand now, I don't... I may also have to get online to look into it. It should be...it's possible that the data gets updated every year.

Investigator: That's okay. Now I'm just wondering...there are also some hospitals that have to put up extra beds. So for those hospitals, we'll just...

Nurse: You come over to take a look first. If the situation is urgent, if there is a special circumstance, or if there is no special situation but you can still make an appointment in advance. Let's say, if a patient gets discharged from the hospital, then we can make the arrangements to let you in. Because relatively speaking and under normal circumstances, we're nearly at capacity.

Investigator: Ah, that's fine. Now I know.

Nurse: Because for anything regarding the patient's condition or treatments, it is best to talk to the professor in person. That's the best way.

Investigator: Okay. Hey, I would like to ask, that is to say, at your Tongji Hospital in Wuhan, on which day does the professor himself...? On which week day, such as on Monday morning or afternoon, does he come to the clinic?

Nurse: Okay, as for the clinic hours, it is impossible (for any professor) to come every day, that is, basically from Monday to Friday there's always a professor on duty at the clinic, but professors' clinic hours are different every day.

Investigator: Okay, that's good. Anyway, now it's certain that your Tongji Hospital does the best job at it in Wuhan, right?

Nurse: That's right.

Investigator: That's good. Then I'll double check it.

Nurse: Okay, good.

Investigator: Ah, good. That's fine. Thank you! Bye!
