Summary

1. There is a shortage of beds at our hospital.
2. Investigator: Starting from the admission, the lab tests, and finally to the transplant operation--all these are to be done in one month. Do you think it all can be done by the end of the year?
Doctor: It depends on the situation. Under normal circumstances, it does not take a month.
3. Investigator: It doesn't take half a month to get the surgery done after getting admitted into the hospital, right?
Doctor: I mean, if it goes well, it does not take half a month.

Translation

Nurse: Hello, how do you do?

Investigator: Hi, how do you do? Hi, is this Kidney Transplant of the First Affiliated Hospital of Jinan University?

Nurse: Um, who is this?

Investigator: Ah, I just want to ask, is there a shortage of beds now in your kidney transplant inpatient service? How's the wait time?

(Passing the phone to a doctor): Hello, hi!

Investigator: Hi, Doctor! I'm a relative of a patient, we did the examination in Dongyuan, and the doctor over there recommended that we go to the First Affiliated Hospital of Jinan University to get it done. So I'd like to know...

Doctor: Yes, yes, then you let him come to the clinic.

Investigator: That is to say, is there a shortage of the beds now? Are there many patients on your waiting list, for transplants?

Doctor: The bed supply is tight, pretty tight at our hospital. But you can come first, first, because we have turnover beds every day, and have those patients who come and go every day, so I wouldn't say that we have to book it first.

Doctor: How about this, you come to take a look first, you can come over, ask questions, and learn more about us.

Investigator: He recommended Doctor Su, who is a chief physician, with very good technical skills. So can we ask Dr. Su to do the operation himself for our relative?

Doctor: Okay. okay.

Investigator: Dr. Su is Su Xuejun, right? Doctor Su Xuejun?

Doctor: Ah, yes, yes.

Investigator: He is still the chief surgeon now, isn't he?

Doctor: Um.

Investigator: If he does it, then we wouldn't mind spending some money. Can we designate Dr. Su to do the operation for us?

Doctor: Ah, that's fine, as long as he is not on a business trip.

Investigator: So that means, from the admission, the lab tests, and finally to the transplant operation--all these are to be done in one month. Do you think it all can be done by the end of the year?

Doctor: It depends on the situation. If things go normally, it doesn't take a month.

Investigator: Oh, it doesn't take half a month to get it done after getting admitted into the hospital, right?

Doctor: I mean, if it goes well, it does not take half a month. However, if the patient has a special situation, I will say, I must see if the patient has anything else going on, because an uremia patient often comes with many other diseases.

Investigator: That is to say, if he has no other complications, under normal circumstances, it certainly can all be done within one month, from the admission, lab tests, to the transplant surgery. Is that so?

Doctor: Uh, uh, uh! My patient is calling me now, I have to go for that, okay? and for the consultation, please come over to take a look, okay?
