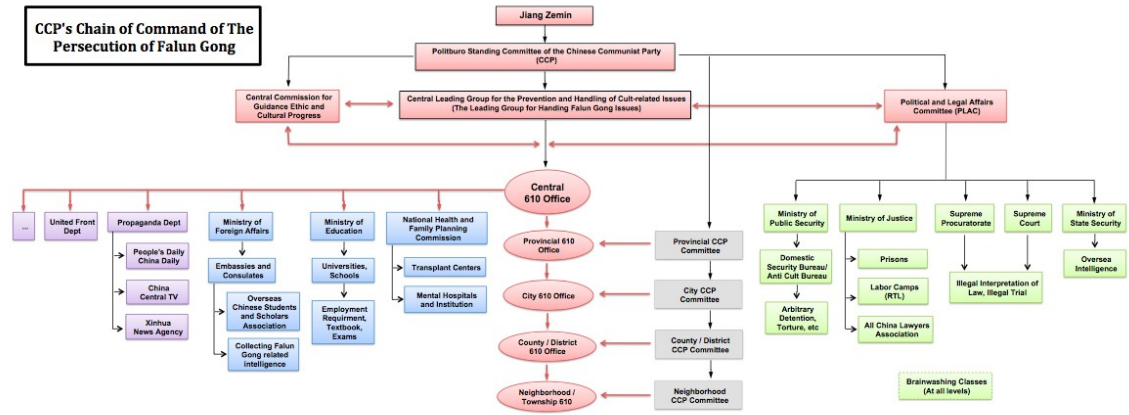

World Organization to Investigate the Persecution of Falun Gong (WOIPFG)

To investigate the criminal conduct of all institutions, organizations, and individuals involved in the persecution of Falun Gong; to bring such investigation, no matter how long it takes, no matter how far and deep we have to search, to full closure; to exercise fundamental principles of humanity; and to restore and uphold justice in society



*Note: On June 7, 1999, Jiang Zemin announced at a Politburo meeting the establishment of the "Leading Group for Handling of Falun Gong Issues (of Chinese Communist Party Central Committee CCPCCI)" and its office. The office is also called the "Central 610 Office" due to the date of its establishment. The Central 610 Office made its first public appearance on February 26, 2001, under the name of the "Office of the Prevention and Handling of Cult-related Issues of the State Council". In 2003, the "Leading Group for Handling of Falun Gong Issues of CCPCCI" was renamed the "Leading Group for the Prevention and Handling of Cult-related Issues of CCPCCI", and the "Office of the Leading Group for Handling of Falun Gong Issues" was changed accordingly to the "Office of the Leading Group for Prevention and Handling of Cult-related Issues", which continued to be called the "Office for Prevention and Handling of Cult-related Issues of the State Council" and was included among the institutions directly under the Chinese Communist Party's Central Committee, while retaining its name of "Central 610 Office" at the same time. The CCP Central Committee's "Plan on Deepening Reform of Party and State Institutions", which was released on March 21, 2018, assigned the duties of the "Leading Group for Prevention and Handling of Cult-related Issues of CCPCCI" and its office to the Central Political and Legal Affairs Committee and the Ministry of Public Security.
