Investigation Recording

Investigator: Hello, how are you? Hello!

Doctor: Hello, how are you?

Investigator: Hello. You are Panyu Branch of the Second Hospital Affiliated to Guangzhou University of Medical Science, right?

Doctor: Who is this?

Investigator: Hi, I am calling from Guangzhou. I am a relative of a patient who wants to do kidney transplant. We called before, and learned that something happened during the pandemic.

Doctor: Oh, you want to be put on the waiting list?

Investigator: Right, we want to be put on the waiting list.

Doctor: First, you schedule an appointment for morning clinic, and then you come to the clinic, the doctor will help you register. He will tell you the relevant information, and that will do. And then you just wait for phone notification, which will ask you to come for hospitalization and medical examination, and the patient will stay in the hospital for around one week. You just need to follow what I am telling you.

Investigator: Oh, okay. I'd like to ask, doctor, if everything is completed, including tissue matching, how much time will be needed in waiting? I'd like to ask about that, so that we can make arrangement at home.

Doctor: This is hard to say, it can be anytime. Today we are also doing surgeries, I was just saying, after the patient is done with medical examination, there will be a period of time...

Investigator: You are doing it during the pandemic. I am thinking, if our turn will come within a month, then we will plan for a month.

Doctor: It is hard to say (if your turn can come) within a month. My estimate is, it is very hard to do it within a month.

Investigator: Oh, this is the case.

Doctor: Very hard to get to the top of the line. You can only wait, okay? I can't tell you a specific time.



Investigator: Okay. Alright. Doctor, if I can register, which specialist should I register to see?

Doctor: You don't need to register to see a specialist, just make a morning appointment and that will do. That morning, a doctor will help you register.

Investigator: I see, so I register online.

Doctor: Then wait for phone notification.

Investigator: Alright then. Thank you. I saw online there was a Director Chen Zheng. Doctor, are you Director Chen Zheng?

Doctor: No.

Investigator: Oh.

Doctor: When you called the hospital office, didn't the director answer your call?

Investigator: But I thought Director Chen Zheng is the best, isn't he?

Doctor: Do you know Director Chen?

Investigator: No, I saw it online, you have a pretty good introduction online.

Doctor: Yeah.

Investigator: Right, currently it's Director Chen Zheng who performs surgery, right?

Doctor: Most of the time.

Investigator: Most of the time. It says online...

Doctor: We are doing a few hundred cases a year; it can't be just him doing it. Other doctors do it too.

Investigator: Also, Director Pan Guanghui is doing it too, as mentioned on the website. And there is Ma Junjie too. Are the three of them on the same team?

Doctor: Well, let's talk about it after you have come to register, Okay?

Investigator: I was just wondering...if we...how many cases do you do in a year? It might be affected this year due to the pandemic.

Doctor: Let's talk about this when you come, okay?

Investigator: I just don't like...there are also hospitals that just do a couple of cases a year, and I won't go to that kind of hospitals. I think a hospital that does a lot must have more technical expertise, right? Doctor, am I right thinking this way?

Doctor: You are right, you are right regardless of the way you think.

Investigator: Hahaha

Doctor: This is a working phone number, okay?

Investigator: Right.

Doctor: It is not a consultation number, okay?

Investigator: I am the relative of a patient, so you are working, right? How much money should I prepare, doctor?



Doctor: Let's talk about it when you come. We don't give advice over the phone. I am telling you how to proceed; we don't do phone consultation, okay? This is a phone for work within the hospital.

Investigator: Okay, okay! It is not that easy for me to make a phone call. Doctor, I am asking you one last question. About the hospital beds for kidney transplant patients, how many inpatients are there now? Are there many patients? I just wanted to know the situation with the hospital. The patients that are hospitalized...

Doctor: About this....

Investigator: How many kidney transplant patients?

Doctor: I can't disclose how many patients there are now. Please don't try to pry on situation within our department. I will not provide you with such information.

Investigator: This is confidential?

Doctor: You need to come to register and be put on the waiting line. If you want, come and wait in line here. When you are notified to come for hospitalization, you will know, okay?

Investigator: Doctor, you are a doctor, right? You are a doctor, you are a doctor, aren't you?

Doctor: Yes.

Investigator: What's your name, doctor? When I come, I will ask for you.

Doctor: You don't need to ask for me, go directly to morning clinic doctor. There are doctors at the clinic in the morning, and they sit at the clinic on Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday. These doctors may appear at random at the clinic, okay?

Investigator: It is Tuesday, Wednesday, and Friday, isn't it? Registration for morning clinic, it's Tuesday, Wednesday, and Friday, right?

Doctor: Right.

Investigator: Right, there is one more thing. Why did I ask for your help? Because my friend told me—my family has a relative in this section—he said to me that when I go to the hospital, I should find a doctor and tell him that I prefer a donor who practices Qigong, like Falun Gong practitioners, who do not drink or smoke, and for that type I am willing to pay. This is the favor I need from you. This is what I meant. Are there any like that? Are there any nowadays?

Doctor: You just come, there will be a doctor to see you, there will be a doctor to see you. And then there will be arrangement for your hospitalization, and after medical check up at the hospital, there will be a doctor assigned for you, okay?

Investigator: Oh, I was wondering if you could do me this favor, so that I don't need to ask anyone else. That is, I just want a Falun Gong donor, not other types. They don't smoke or drink, isn't that great? So healthy!

Doctor: I...this I can't help you with, okay? Let us do it the regular way, okay? This is in-patient division here.

Investigator: I was thinking, if you could help me, I don't need to ask anyone else, isn't that good! And you happen to be a doctor, isn't that great?

Doctor: It is not about whom you want to help you. About this thing, tell you a simple truth, it's just like dating, can you determine when you can get a date? Right? We will give priority to all patients who need matching donors, we'll try to find matching donors for all of them. But to find a good match, they have to be right for each other, you understand?
