



## **Investigation Respondent: Liu Yueying, Registration Office, Liver Transplant Department, Jiangxi Provincial People's Hospital**

### **Summary:**

1. So far this year, 50 liver transplants have been done. Last year, there should also be several dozen cases. There were several dozen cases done every year.
2. Currently, it's still Director Xu Zhidan performing liver transplants, he started doing it in 2012.
3. Investigator: I want to make it clear I want organs from Falun Gong practitioners who do not smoke or drink. I just want this type. I am willing to pay however much you ask for.

4. To do a liver transplant due to cirrhosis, you need to prepare around 500,000 to 600,000 rmb yuan. Provincial medical insurance can be used, but the liver source fees cannot be covered.

Investigator: Hello! This is Jiangxi Provincial People's Hospital, isn't it?

Liu Yueying: Yes.

Investigator: Is this the transplant department?

Liu Yueying: Yes, it is.

Investigator: This is my situation. I have a family member who needs a liver transplant. We haven't been there before, so I need some information.

Liu Yueying: Liver transplant or kidney transplant?

Investigator: Liver transplant.

Liu Yueying: I...I...I think you should at least bring the patient's medical reports here.

Investigator: Ah, ah.

Liu Yueying: For now the patient doesn't have to come.

Investigator: Ah, okay. How long does the patient have to wait before he gets done, the fastest?

Liu Yueying: Oh, you mean the quality of the organ source?

Investigator: Yes, exactly.

Liu Yueying: Yes, we can!

Investigator: That's great!

Liu Yueying: Of course we can.

Investigator: I also want to make it clear that I want an organ from a Falun Gong practitioner who does not smoke or drink. I just want this type. I will pay however much you ask for, so I have to make this call myself.

Liu Yueying: Ah, okay, so remember to mention this matter when you see Director Xu in person, alright?

Investigator: I need to mention this to Director Xu. Okay! You remember this, please. What is your last name? How can I find you later?

Liu Yueying: My last name is Liu.

Investigator: Liu, okay.

Liu Yueying: What's your relationship to the patient? Let me ask you again, what's your relationship to the patient?

Investigator: He is my nephew, He's my nephew, my sister's child.

Liu Yueying: So he's your nephew?

Investigator: Right, right, right, my sister has always taken good care of me since childhood.

Liu Yueying: I see.

Investigator: So, I am being grateful to my sister. That's how things are.
