Investigation Recording

Nurse: Hello!

Investigator: Could you connect me to the Transplant Department?

Nurse: Hello! Transplant Department.

Investigator: Hi, is this the First Affiliated Hospital of Kunming Medical College? You are the Transplant

Department, aren't you?

Nurse: Yes.

Investigator: How are you? One of my family members needs to do a liver transplant.

Nurse: Oh, just a second. You can bring the patient and the patient's medical records over on a regular working day.

Investigator: May I ask, are you a doctor or a nurse?

Nurse: We're nurses here. And there's a specific teacher who's in charge of transplantation.

Investigator: Could you tell me which director is in charge?

Nurse: This...there are several of them. It varies depending on the day.

Nurse: So you can come directly for consultation tomorrow.
